play for a draw? They know they can never beat us
at home.

Red 3 I expect they will pack the defence.

Red 4 Yes, for them a draw would be like a victory.

*A group of BLUES' SUPPORTERS come in from the opposite side of the stage.
ZOE, a Blues' supporter, sits down and starts to eat her lunch.*

Reds' Leader Hey guys, what have we here? It's a group of those
useless Blues . . . did your mums let you out on
your own?

Blue 1 You won't be saying that when we give you the
thrashing you deserve.
